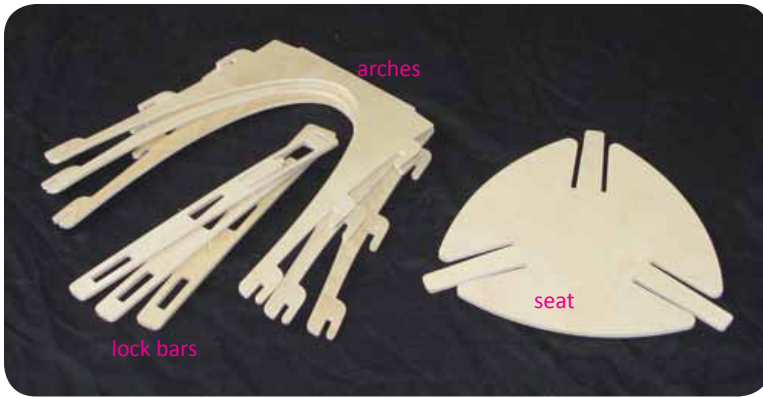


## Tuffet Stool Assembly Instructions

The following instructions apply to the Plydea Tuffet Stool. Note that parts are called out in green. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us at [plydea.com](http://plydea.com)!



### **Pic 1**

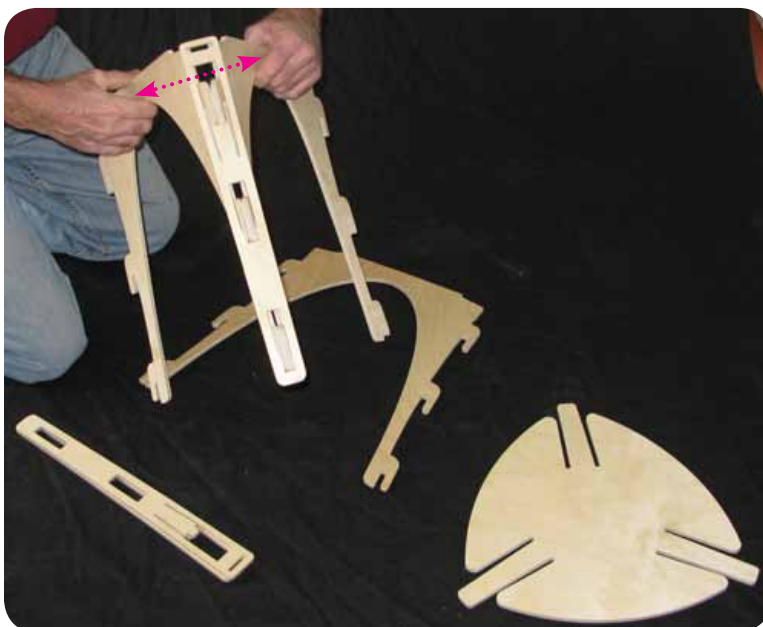
Use two hands for seven parts:

- 3 arches
- 3 lock bars
- 1 seat



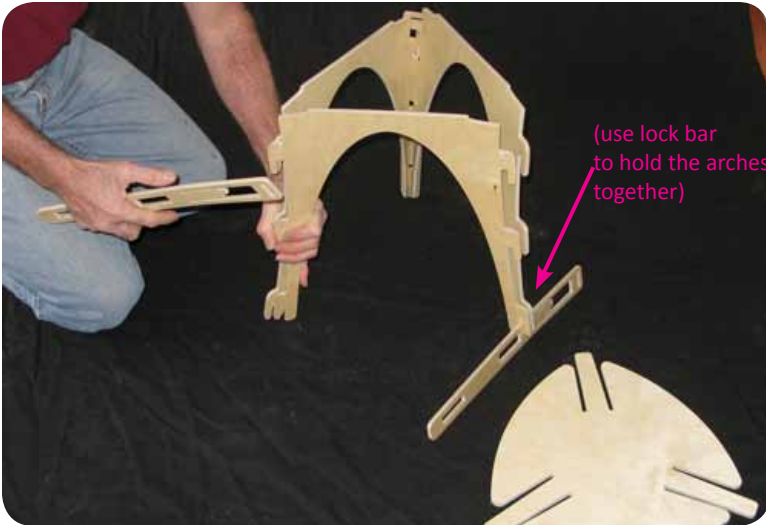
### **Pic 2**

Choosing the faces you want to see and arranging them appropriately, grab two arches and slide on a lock bar starting at the foot end



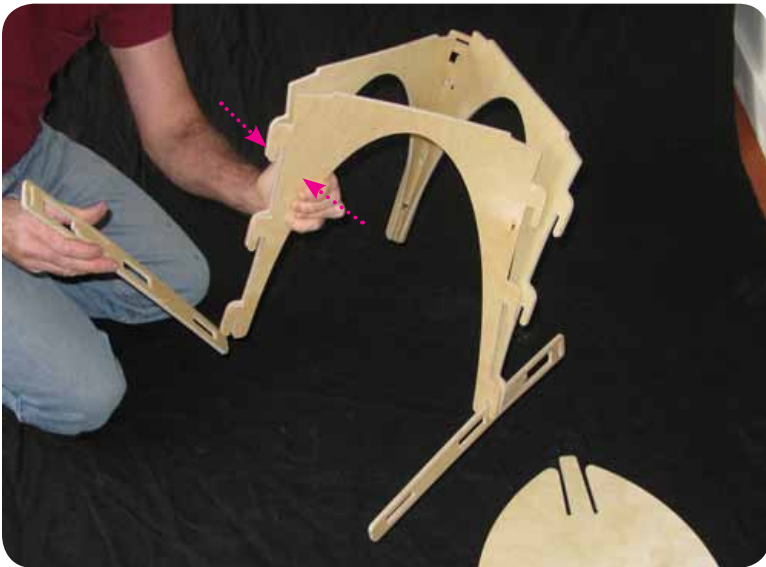
### **Pic 3**

grab the third arch and spread the first two arches apart



**Pic 4**

use a **lock bar** on the floor as shown to hold the first and second **arches** together...



**Pic 5**

squeeze the last **arch** to the first **arch** and slip on the **lock bar** starting at the foot end



**Pic 6**

now squeeze the remaining **arches** together and **lock bar** them, at this point if all tabs aren't engaging don't sweat it because now you're going to...



**Pic 7**

push against the floor to ensure all **lock bars** are fully engaged -- if they are not - make sure the top tabs of the **arches** are seated on either side of the spacer in the **lock bar**...



**Pic 8**

choosing the face you want to see, insert the first tab of the **seat** into the topmost slot of the **lock bar**.



**Pic 7**

pressing the next **seat** tab gently down pull the top of the **lock bar** out so its top slot slips over the **seat** tab. Now do the same thing with the last **seat** tab.



**Pic 9**

your tough little tuffet is now ready for making speeches to your family.
